



Favorite performing credits include Percy in The Spitfire Grill, Susan in [title of show], Laertes in Fortinbras and Alice in Authenticity. Additional selected credits with Theatre Fairfield include Scenic Designer for Rabbit Hole, Master Carpenter for Silent Sky and The Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night-Time and Director of Hot Wax as part of the 2020 production of Director's Cut. As a Branford resident with a love for theatre and music, she

is beyond excited to be a part of Legacy and their mission to bring inspiring theatre to the community.

EMMETT CASSIDY (Reporter, Joe Jr, Marinaro, Coach) is an actor from Branford, performing in his third production with Legacy Theatre. Previous roles with Legacy have included Laertes (Hamlet, '18), and Elliot (Private Lives, '19), as well as an upcoming role in Expanded Voices: Jamal this July. "A very special thanks to Keeley and Lauren for letting me work with you both on yet another great show, here's to many more to come!"

MITCHEL KAWASH (*Wms*, *Dennis*, *JCB*, *Rep.Administrator*) is thrilled to be returning to the Legacy Theatre for this very special project! He previously appeared as Paul in Legacy's inaugural mainstage production of *Barefoot in*



the Park and as Demetrius in the 2019 outdoor production of A Midsummer Night's Dream. Mitchel holds a BA in Theater Studies with distinction from Yale, where he performed around the world as a member of the a cappella group The Whiffenpoofs. He completed his graduate acting training at the London Academy of Music and Dramatic Art and is currently based in New York. Additional regional credits include the Elm Shakespeare Company (Julius Caesar, dir. Alvin Epstein), the Valley Shakespeare Festival (Our Town, Cyrano, The Taming of the Shrew, The Comedy of Errors, Pericles, Macbeth, A Midsummer Night's Dream, A Christmas Carol and Romeo & Juliet: Choose Your Own Ending), and the Pennsylvania Shakespeare Festival (Hamlet). Mitchel starred in the Off-Broadway musical satire Me the People (writ. Nancy Holson) and has appeared in television shows, short films, radio plays, and a national commercial.

KEELY KNUDSEN (Joan Joyce, Book & Lyrics, Artistic Director & Co-Founder) An award winning director, Keely has performed, directed, and choreographed internationally in plays, musicals, operas, and dance companies in hundreds of theatrical productions and has performed in 48 of the United States and in the UK. Realizing her vision of a new theater company on the Connecticut Shoreline, Keely's ideals of inspiring, inclusive work that uplifts the human spirit and connects communities formalized in the creation of the Legacy Theatre with Co-Founder Stephanie Stiefel Williams, a performing colleague and dear friend. Keely has directed, choreographed, and taught a myriad of performing arts courses at such institutions as Quinnipiac University, Yale University, Fairfield University, Hartt School of Drama, Southern Connecticut State University, Westminster College, and was the Director of Education of New Haven's acclaimed Elm Shakespeare Company for several years. Additionally a composer/lyricist and playwright, she is currently collaborating on two musicals and is a member of ASCAP. Her directing has been heralded by the Arts Paper as "...visually striking, emotionally moving" and "captivating" and of her direction of Hamlet it was said, "Knudsen has made the notoriously difficult Shakespearean language accessible." Her creation of the Wheel Life Theatre Troupe has been an especially rewarding program as she acts and directs with those who ambulate with crutches and wheelchairs. Her BFA is from New York University's Tisch School of the Arts, at which she graduated first in the class, and she received her Masters Degree in Drama on full scholarship from The Royal Scottish Academy of Music and Drama in Glasgow. Keely, her husband Brian, and five children (Saviah, Liviana, Wynter, Emery, and



Reeves) reside in Guilford, CT, where she thoroughly enjoys running the Legacy with a tremendous staff and community support.

TYRELL LATOUCHE (Reporter, Ens, Child Fan, Stadium Announcer) recently made his professional acting debut in Barefoot in the Park. He is a recent college graduate of Quinnipiac University. His Off-Broadway credits include being the playwright of Last Words (The Barrow Group). He's grateful for the opportunity to work with Legacy Theatre.

MOIRA MALONE (Billie Jean, Catcher, Reporter, Mom) is excited to be a part of this Legacy production. Originally from northern NJ, she currently resides in Cheshire and has performed locally as an actor, director, singer, dialect coach, acting coach and voice coach. She holds a Master of Drama from the Royal Scottish Academy of Music & Drama (Glasgow), a certificate in Acting Shakespeare from the Royal Academy of Dramatic Art (London), and a BA in Anthropology with a Vocal Performance minor from the University of Vermont. She has never been a catcher, a reporter or Billie Jean King, but she is a Mom, deeply proud of and grateful for Ian and Ben. MICHAEL SAYERS (Author) In a career in entertainment spanning 50 years, Michael has been seen, heard, and known as an actor, producer, director, writer, playwright, comedian, ringmaster, toastmaster, ficticious detective, voice over artist, cartoon character, and filmmaker. Best known as the Detective Chester Hadlyme, he has, for over 30 years, taken his interactive comedy shows to audiences on Camelot Cruise Murder on the Connecticut River and Carnival Cruise Lines to Colleges and Universities throughout the northeast, and most recently a 7 year engagement at Consiglio's Restaurant on Wooster Street in New Haven. The Covid 19 pandemic brought about a change of plans for a project that was in the works for a stage presentation, but transformed into a film project. His narrated compilation of selected stories and poems of Edgar Allan Poe, "Poetic", was completed when the final segment to be included, "The Masque of the Red Death", was brilliantly scored, illustrated, and finished. The film is currently competing in festivals. He is also very proud to be invited to be in the first show in a new theatre.

BRAD ROSS (Composer) Winner of the Richard Rodgers Award, composer Brad Ross has three musicals published by Concord Theatricals. The Kennedy Center commissioned and premiered Brad's musical *The Tales of Custard the*



Dragon, based on the books by Ogden Nash. His musical, Little by Little, ran Off-Broadway at New York's York Theatre Company with Vocal Selections published by Alfred Music. Brad's symphonic story, A Family for Baby Grand for Narrator and Symphony Orchestra, performed has been including by over 20 orchestras The National Symphony and The Philadelphia Orchestra, and recorded by The Rochester Philharmonic. Brad's musical setting of 'Twas the Night Before Christmas has been performed by solo vocalists and choirs with 25 orchestras. Brad composed the scores for two musicals for young performers that were premiered at The Interlakes Summer Theatre in Meredith, NH: Sparkle Spa! (based on the Simon & Schuster book series) and *Peanut Butter* and Cupcake (based on the Penguin book). Brad is a graduate of Cornell University (Bachelor of Music) and New York University (MFA, Graduate Musical Theater Writing Program). He has music directed several productions at such venues as Ivoryton Playhouse, Guilford High School, Wilbur Cross High School, St. Rita's School, and for the Whitney Players. Currently he serves as Minister of Music at Seymour Congregational Church, and accompanies for vocal tutorials at Yale School of Drama, as well as doing a fair amount of freelance work. This is his second collaboration with the Legacy team, having provided musical support for *Polkadots*. A resident of Guilford for the past 30 years, Dave enjoys longdistance hiking, biking, and generally being outdoors in his spare time.

JAMIE BURNETT (Set & Lighting Designer) is a Founding member of The Elm Shakespeare Company. The Summer of 2019s production of Love's Labour's Lost was his 23rd Season with the illustrious company. As resident Set and Lighting Designer for the Elm Shakespeare Company he designed lighting for every production for the past 23 years. He has designed sets for almost every production till 2009. International Festival of Arts and ideas 2018, Lighting design: Requiem for and Electric Chair, 2017 Never Stand Still, Iseman Theater, Collective Conciousness Theater company: Lighting Design. The past few years he has lit the main hall in the New Haven Armory with artistic lighting for the Citywide Open Studios events serving the unique art installations there. With Projects for a New Millennium, he was Designer for the Stamford Train Station Façade Lighting. Producer/Lighting Designer/ Production Manager for 2014 hit Terra Tractus (The Earth Moves), Also (2005) Terra Mirabila, (2001) Terra Lumina and Terra Continuum (1999) the grand multimedia extravaganzas all performed in the Stony Creek Granite Quarry. He also designed PNM's Branford Luminata (2010) lighting the town hall on the Branford Green. He is a consultant, Lighting and Set designer, special events planner, and film/video Gaffer as well as a licensed electrical contractor. His company, Luminous Environments, specializes in Theater and TV Studio Renovations and site-specific public art installations involving specialized lighting. His latest Projects include Branford High school Theater, Fairfield Community Theater, Southington High School Theater and This very Theater as consultant and Lighting and rigging Systems design and installation. He is a 2005 recipient of the New Haven Arts Award.

COURTNEY DURSO (Assistant Stage Manager & Intern) is a rising senior at Boston University majoring in Film and Television with minors in Theatre Arts and Arts Leadership. A lifelong lover of theatre, she has been seeing shows since she was six months old and has performed in multiple productions, some of her favorites including *Assassins*, 9 to 5 and *Into the Woods*. She is excited to join the Legacy family!

ADAM JACKSON (Sound Engineer) is honored to be a part of Legacy Theatre's Inaugural Season. Adam has been involved in nearly 30 productions, doing everything from rigging lights to acting onstage to calling cues. Onstage, Adam has most enjoyed portraying the likenesses of J. Bruce Ismay in Titanic (2017), Henry David Thoreau in The Night Thoreau Spent in Jail (2017), Farquaad in Shrek (2018), Ebenezer Scrooge in A Christmas Carol (2018), and both Lucas Beineke and Gomez Addams (understudy, performed) in The Addam's Family (2019). Adam was head stage manager for Shoreline Theatre Company's Inaugural Season and has continued to work with them since, doing lighting and sound effect design. Adam has worked as a sound engineer for various productions and concerts, and more recently, has helped produce several live-streamed events during the Covid-19 Pandemic. Adam is currently studying music education at Western Connecticut State University with a concentration in classical trombone. Aside from theatre, Adam is a vocalist



and keyboardist at The River Church in Danbury and works on many of his own projects, which have previously included recording an album of barbershop songs, conducting several big band recording sessions, and planning a live concert (pre-covid) in Branford which included the performances of over 30 musicians from all over Connecticut.

SALATTO-ROSENAY LAUREN (Projection Designer, Book and Lyrics & Production Stage Manager) is thrilled to be joining The Legacy Theatre during their inaugural season as Company Manager and as the first stage manager in their new building. She has been an actor, director, designer, stage manager, playwright and more. It has been a true honor for her to bring Joan Joyce's incredible legacy to the stage, for all to realize that anything is possible. In recent years, Lauren has been involved with Legacy's production of Hamlet as stage manager, and acted in A Midsummer Night's Dream in the role of Titania. Other acting credits include Audrey in Little Shop of Horrors, Matilde in The Clean House (directed by Keely Baisden Knudsen), the Baker's Wife in Into The Woods, and Dr Diaforius in The Imaginary Invalid. Lauren graduated from Quinnipiac University summa cum laude receiving the President's Scholarship Award, double majoring in theater and communications. In 2018, Lauren became a proud critic of the CT Critics Circle. She has been involved

in The New Play Festival, produced at The Barrow Group, an Off-Broadway theater, as a playwright, director, actor and stage manager. Lauren will be starting Law School this fall to pursue entertainment law.

STEPHANIE STIEFEL WILLIAMS (Co-Founder & Chairperson of the Board) has spent her entire adult life as a professional performer in musicals, concerts, and plays throughout the Northeast. As Miss Connecticut, she represented the state at the Miss America Pageant in Atlantic City. In addition to her position on Legacy's Board, Stephanie is a member of the Board of Trustees at the Goodspeed Opera House and the Performing Arts Advisory Council at the University of Notre Dame. She has become involved on a producing level with productions of Gypsy and Showboat in London's West End, the recent award-winning revival of Sweeney Todd in New York, and Broadway's Escape to Margaritaville. A former attorney, she received her juris doctorate with honors from the University of Connecticut School of Law.

G I N A M A R C A N T O N I O (Development Director) is the Immediate-Past President of the Association of Fundraising Professionals (AFP), Connecticut Chapter and a seasoned fund development professional with over 25 years of experience

COLIN SHEEHAN (Artistic Coordinator & Director of Public Relations) is a local arts enthusiast and serves as Director of The Branford High School Performing Arts' Spring Musical, Artistic Director of Tabor Arts Branford and Co-Founder and Co-Artistic Director of Shoreline Theatre Company in association with The Branford Parks and Recreation Department. He graduated from Branford High School in 2003 and continued his studies at Wagner College ('07) with a B.A. in Theatre and Speech Performance.
